

After working through some bumps along the way and mastering a sharp learning curve, teachers have adapted quickly to continue teaching in a new method.

Students and families too have adapted to the change in learning. It has not been easy and there will be the occasional bumps but we work them out as education partners in this uncertain time.

As the principal, I continue my role to supervise the overall programming and ensure that it is delivered and received properly. I had the chance to randomly pop into some of the online classes in recent weeks. There are a variety of methods that lessons are being delivered by teachers and not all are actual live online classes. Some are lessons delivered by email, a recorded video, link to a video, or in Google Classroom. The individual teachers will contact the students to inform them of the lessons' format. So it is important that students check their email and Google Classroom for instructions from the teachers.

We will continue to work together to ensure the continuing success of our students. As more information becomes available, we will be in contact with families. For now, we ask that you take care of yourself and your family and contact the school for any assistance. We are here for you.






Indicate your child's measurements on the attached sizing guide and leave the size column on the order form blank.
